

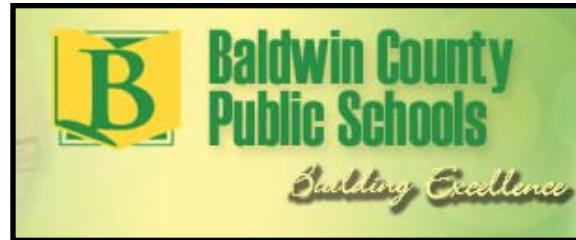

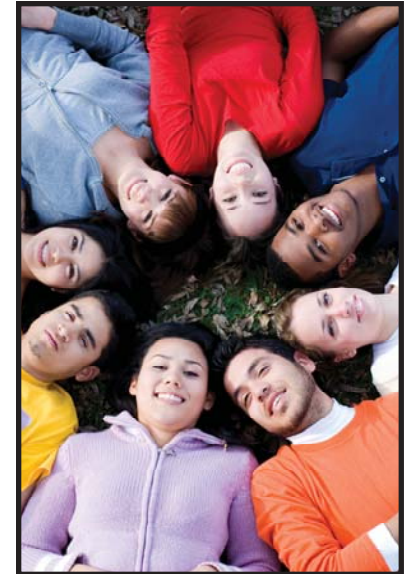

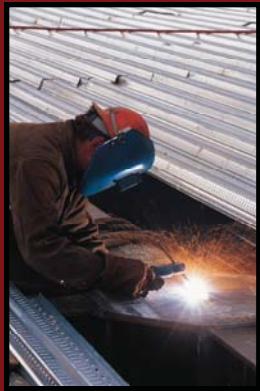

DUAL ENROLLMENT CREDIT

Earn College Credit Now!

Students who attend the Centers for Technology in the Baldwin County Public School System may earn college credit at Faulkner State Community College at no cost to eligible students. The career technical courses authorized for dual enrollment at Faulkner State are related to highly skilled jobs in which workers are in demand in the Baldwin County area.



These career technical dual enrollment courses lead toward certificates or Associate degrees in:

- Automotive Technology
- Building Construction
- Computer-Aided Drafting
- Industrial Maintenance
- Welding Technology

STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Must be enrolled in high school course(s) associated with career technical dual enrollment.
- Overall high school GPA of 2.5 or higher. Students with a GPA between 2.0 and 2.5 become eligible by scoring at level 3 of the WIN placement tests in the subjects of Applied Mathematics, Locating Information, and Reading for Information.
- GPA of 3.0 or higher in career technical courses related to program.
- Submit a Faulkner State application for admission.
- Submit a Career Technical Dual Enrollment Approval Form.
- Submit one original high school transcript.

Course grades will be posted to the Faulkner State transcript at the end of each semester.

It is possible for high school students to finish a certificate program at Faulkner State by the time of high school graduation; thereby, allowing for participation in the Faulkner State graduation.



TRAINING THE WORKFORCE OF TOMORROW

ARTICULATION CREDIT

Students enrolled in Cosmetology at the Centers for Technology who do not meet the dual enrollment eligibility criteria or students who took courses prior to 2008-2009 may request articulation credit for specific courses after high school graduation. To be eligible for articulation credit, students must enroll at Faulkner State within 16 months after high school graduation.
